

Dilution Control



1. Common Resilient Floor Strippers

Diluting concentrated cleaner with water in proper proportions is efficient and practical. Too much concentrate can:

- o Damage surface being cleaned
- o Harm skin
- o Make too many suds
- o Waste material
- o Waste time
- o Increase residue

Too little concentrate can:

- o Not do the cleaning job – it will have to be done over again
- o Waste time
- o Waste energy
- o Waster material

Concentrated cleaners are diluted with water in specific amounts to do specific cleaning jobs. Use a sensible system for measuring. You will always know the cost, the strength and the results will be the same. *NOTE: Use manufacturer's dilution rates for measuring. Then you will always know the cost, the strength and the result will be the same.*

Standard Dilution Table

Diluting Instructions	Amount of Concentrate	Amount of Water
4 to 1	32 oz	1 Gallon / 4 L
5 to 1	26 oz	1 Gallon / 4 L
10 to 1	13 oz	1 Gallon / 4 L
15 to 1	8.5 oz	1 Gallon / 4 L
20 to 1	6.5 oz	1 Gallon / 4 L
25 to 1	5.5 oz	1 Gallon / 4 L
30 to 1	4.33 oz	1 Gallon / 4 L
40 to 1	3.33 oz	1 Gallon / 4 L
60 to 1	2.33 oz	1 Gallon / 4 L
64 to 1	2 oz	1 Gallon / 4 L
85 to 1	1.5 oz	1 Gallon / 4 L
128 to 1	1 oz	1 Gallon / 4 L
256 to 1	0.5 oz	1 Gallon / 4 L

Tips

Automatically mix concentrate and water at the faucet. Feed line must be clean and not crimped. Activating button must be used to get the concentrate into the water. Color coded lines on the bucket and the measuring cup assist in providing good dilution results. Pumps help measure accurately.
