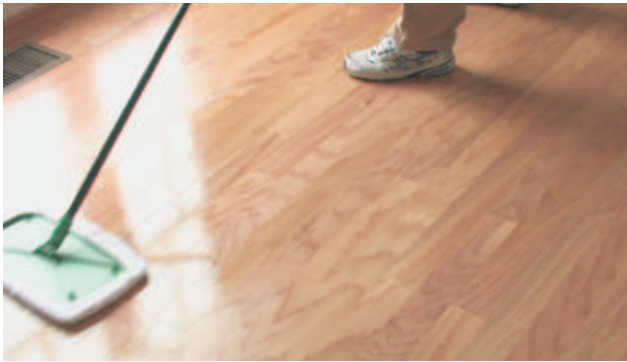


Mopping



Maintain Your Mop

Pointers

- Always “cut in” first
- Mop the floor area using the figure eight pattern
- Overlap each pass
- Keep the weight of the mop on the floor
- Use both sides of the mop

**To turn the mop over, keep the mop on the floor and gently roll over to avoid splashing walls and baseboards*

Mopping Solution Pointers

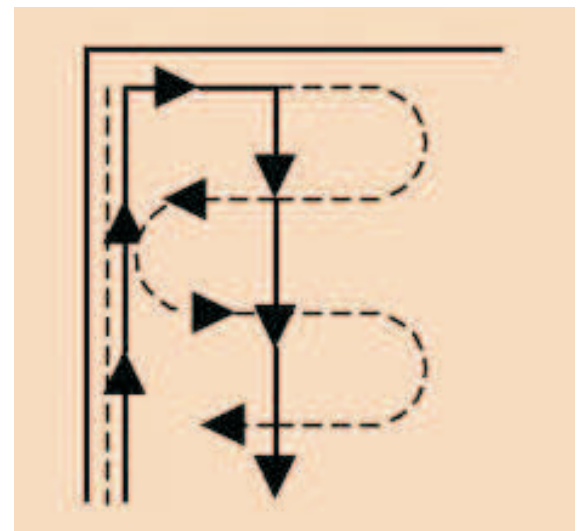
- Proper dilution of concentrated cleaner is essential
- Use cool to cold water to mix the solution. Hot water will dry too fast and may effect the floor finish
- Change the mopping solution when it becomes soiled or as directed by a supervisor. Dirty solution cannot clean
- Wear non-skid shoes or overshoes
- Take care around wooden baseboards and furniture. Solution may damage finish
- Do not leave mop strings caught on legs and feet of furniture

Cutting-in

- Mopping floor edges and corners keeping the mop parallel to the wall

Why Cut-in?

- Eliminates splashing on walls and baseboards which then must be hand wiped
- Control dirty build-up in corners and along edges
- The area of least wear needs the most care



Damp Mop & Wet Mop

Why Damp Mop?

- To clean the floor
- To lengthen time between refinishing the floor

Procedure

1. Dust mop the floor
2. Use one bucket with properly diluted cleaner
3. Cut-in using a wrung out mop
4. Mop floor area with wrung out mop using the figure eight pattern

Clean Up

1. Rinse mop with clear water
2. Hang up mop to dry
3. Rinse and wipe out wringer
4. Rinse and wipe out bucket
5. Store bucket upside down

Why Wet Mop?

To remove heavy soil

Procedure

1. Sweep or dust mop the floor
2. Put out "Wet Floor" signs
3. Cut-in with a dripping mop
4. Apply solution to floor area. Use the figure eight pattern for efficiency
5. Pick up solution using a wrung out mop again in a figure eight-until floor is no longer wet
6. If rinsing is required, repeat four and five with the rinse solution made up of clear water

Clean Up

1. Rinse mop with clear water
2. Hang mop to dry
3. Rinse and wipe out wringer
4. Rinse and wipe out bucket
5. Store bucket upside down
